- > Sulfur dioxide
- Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs)
- > Heavy metals

ONLY YOU CAN MINIMIZE THE RISK!

Sort out non-burnable trash before burning DO NOT open burn trash on the ground Contain and control fire at all times Burn trash in an enclosed burn box with good airflow
